

Charities Act Update

The implementation of the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008 moves on a pace with the legislation which provides for the information gateway between HMRC and the new Commission being debated and passed by both the Commons and the Lords last week. However, the regulations have not yet been made to allow for the transfer of HMRC records and data to the Commission for it to utilise when establishing the new registered charities for Northern Ireland.
